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This is a compliance document for circulation to customers, manufacturers and suppliers. Please make sure the appropriate people in your company are given a copy of this document.

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Purpose

The purpose of this specification is to ensure that supplied food contact dry goods are suitable for contact with wine and beverages.

Guidance

All queries regarding the requirements of this specification should be directed through the customer's Account Manager.

Requirements

All food contact dry goods bought by Vinpac International are required to have relevant food safety declarations accompanying. These are to be kept on file at Vinpac International.

If a change is made to a dry good, including if a new raw material or a new manufacturing process is used, a new food safety declaration must be provided.

The food safety declaration must be for the product as supplied by the supplier to Vinpac; declarations from the agent will not be accepted.

The declaration must cover relevant Australian, European and American food safety regulations including, but not inclusive to, the regulations listed below in references.
